<p>COMPREHENSION: SEQUENCE Put pictures in order that tells the story.</p> <p>✓ <i>Put them in correct order.</i></p>	<p>COMPREHENSION: Characteristics</p> <p><i>Circle the people who are part of the story.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Give student pictures of persons who are in the story and persons who are NOT in it.</i></p> <p>✓ <i>Choose all the people who are in the story..</i></p>
