Focus	Action
Show Sizes	<p>Students use letters of a word to create a picture of what a size word means.</p> <p>For example short tall</p>
Show Shapes	<p>Students use letters of a word to illustrate what the shape is. For example</p> <p style="text-align: center;">t e r l g n a i</p>
Math Thesaurus	Students make lists of terms with similar meanings that are useful in math.
Math Alphabet	Students make an alphabet of words that are meaningful in math, from Add to Zero.
Math Prefixes	Students identify math prefixes that are part of everyday life, such as tri.
Math Verbs	Students make a list of words that are useful in solving math problems. They draw picture or write synonyms for these verbs.
Math Crosswords	Have students create picture clues or sentence clues for a math cross-word puzzle that relates to the math topic you are teaching.
Quantities	Students make a quantity chart using words for sizes, measurement, kinds of amounts.
