

## Action Plan for Career-Structured Learning

### Goal: To increase student responsibility for learning

How will you organize the work-based structures for your classes?

- during Lab days students will work in teams with different responsibilities
  - during each day students will take demonstration roles
  - on Lab days I will assign work for students to complete during the first 15 minutes while I brief "lead" students who will then take the job of supervising different activities— or the same activity but at different stations
  - I will organize a simulation in which the students have positions in a realistic workplace such as a salon or auto repair shop or clinic or hotel or building company
