<p><u>Example</u>                      ...does not "get" the theme or lesson/message of a story—gives the title instead.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Follows the plot, does not think about the story's meaning/message</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Does not know what theme means</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Does not know how to figure out the message/lesson/theme of a story</li> </ul>	<p> model--think out loud—what is a theme, how do you figure it out—with a one-page story</p> <p> list important parts of the story, analyze what the writer is trying to have you think/learn by telling you those events</p>
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
