




## Compare 2 characters

She had been hoping they would take the teacher <b>away</b> altogether. They had once taken Tommy's teacher away for nearly a month because the history sector had <b>blanked</b> out completely.</p> <p>This shows that she can be <b>selfish</b> when she wants something to happen.</p>
