What is the message/lesson of the story?

The message of the story "The Fun They Had" was that we should be more grateful for the things we have today. For example human teachers and books made of paper should not be taken for granted because in the future we may not have them.

What is the message of the story?

When you only know one side of a story, you make assumptions about the subject of that story that are often inaccurate or biased, and you assume that one persons view is everyones view. For example, she does not know the side of an old school where a kid is failing and gets bullied a lot, but the book tells her about the side of school where children play together and help each other with schoolwork. People often don't know a whole story before they express an opinion about it.
