

Main Idea Interpreter

A painting has a main idea. The artist uses pictures to tell you that idea.

To find the main idea, look at the whole painting.

Look at the parts.

Think: what is the artist telling me?

- 1. What do you think the main idea is? Write it in the circle.
- 2. Then in the boxes put parts of the painting that show you that is the main idea. You can draw them or name them in the boxes.
- 3. Write about the painting. Tell how the artist communicates that main idea
