

Make Interesting Idea-Example Connections

I can locate and collect examples relating to an idea. (CCSSR7) Use to assess or guide progress.

Start with an idea.

It can be a heading in the passage you read.

It can be your own idea.

Write it in the oval.

Then list 2 interesting examples that support that idea—one in each box.

One example should come from the passage. The other example can come from the passage or your experience.

To make this even more interesting, you can draw a picture in each box and then write a caption.
