


Dear Mayor Dailey,

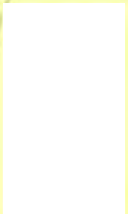
