

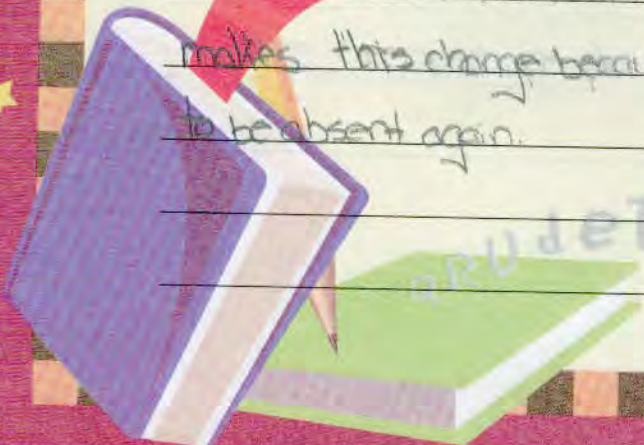
Dear Mayor Daley,
