<p>Homework Schedule consistent time for homework each day. Review and discuss homework—what have you learned?</p>	
<p>Vocabulary Get a vocabulary book or find a vocabulary site on the internet. Choose a topic. List important words about that topic. Write with those words—explain the topic.</p>	
<p>Learning Science and Social Studies Watch a TV program about a science or social studies topic. List important facts. Write about the topic. Draw pictures—make it a booklet.</p>	
<p>Reading Fiction Read a story or novel. Write a summary—what happens, what the lessons are that you can learn from it.</p>	
<p>Math Facts Make and use math “flashcards” to review facts.</p>	
<p>Measurement Math Measure objects and places in your home. Make a chart showing their sizes.</p>	
<p>Math Games Buy or make games to exercise math facts and skills.</p>	

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
