

### Special School Newspaper Issue on the Election

Your class can create a newspaper about the election. The following layout is an example of such a paper that students can create. This project can be completed at the end of your unit on the election.

Here are some of the stories that students can include in such a newspaper issue.

- a) Front page story on what is special about the election.
- b) Feature story on what other students are saying about the election
- c) Editorial supporting one candidate over another.
- d) Political cartoon.
- e) Letters-to-the-editor expressing opinions about a candidate, an issue, or a specific event in the election.

Students can take different jobs on preparing the newspaper: headline writer, layout artist, cartoonist, editorial writer, news reporter.
