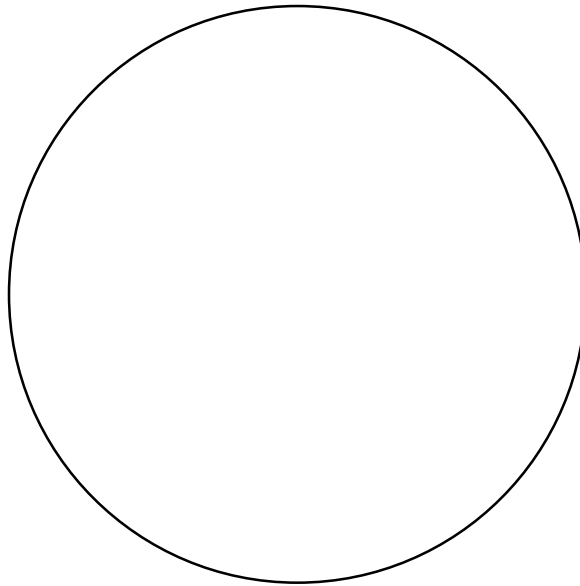


# CIRCLE GRAPH

## **Graph Chicago**
