Idea:

Teach students the skills they need to complete their homework.

Have consequences for students who do not complete their homework.

How to connect teachers with this idea:

We all have this problem, so everyone would want to work at this. Have teachers begin at their grade levels. When beginning to tackle the problem, have regular short focused meetings. Get administration in on the solution.

Getting students to complete their homework.

Idea:

Investigate why students do not complete their homework.

How to connect teachers with this idea:

Getting students to bring in their homework.

Idea:

Set hard consequential rules.

Conferences with parents and/or students.

Recognition to students who bring homework

Have students understand that it is their own grades and overall their own responsibility.

Application:

Call parents.

Lower overall grades.

Set conferences with principal.

Talk to students about expectations.

Praise the homework they bring in and the students who accomplish it.

How to connect teachers with this idea:

Apply the same rules and consequences throughout the school. Establish a uniform homework code throughout the school.

Idea:

Have students tally the number of assignments turned in per week compared to all assigned work.

Have students write monthly goals for improvement.

Application:

Develop tally sheet.

Model behavior with overhead.

Have student leader.

Tally homework on Friday afternoon.

Share results with team teachers at grade level first. As grade level solidifies, offer ideas at teacher in-services.
