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## Picture a Paragraph

*If students take time to draw a picture of an important paragraph in a nonfiction reading, they learn more about the topic and they learn more about reading carefully. (CCSSR1—read closely/carefully)*

*You can do this activity with any nonfiction. You can do it with a story, too.*

*Choose one paragraph that's interesting.  
Draw a picture that shows that paragraph.*

*Give your picture and that page number to someone else.*

*See if they can find your paragraph.*

**Do this activity with the next page to find out how it makes sure you read carefully.**
