

## Picture a Paragraph

If students take time to draw a picture of an important paragraph in a nonfiction reading, they learn more about the topic and they learn more about reading

carefully. (CCSSR1—read closely/carefully)	
You can do this activity with any nonfiction.	You can do it with a story, too.
Choose one paragraph that's interesting. Draw a picture that shows that paragraph.	

Give your picture and that page number to someone else.

See if they can find your paragraph.

Do this activity with the next page to find out how it makes sure you read carefully.
