

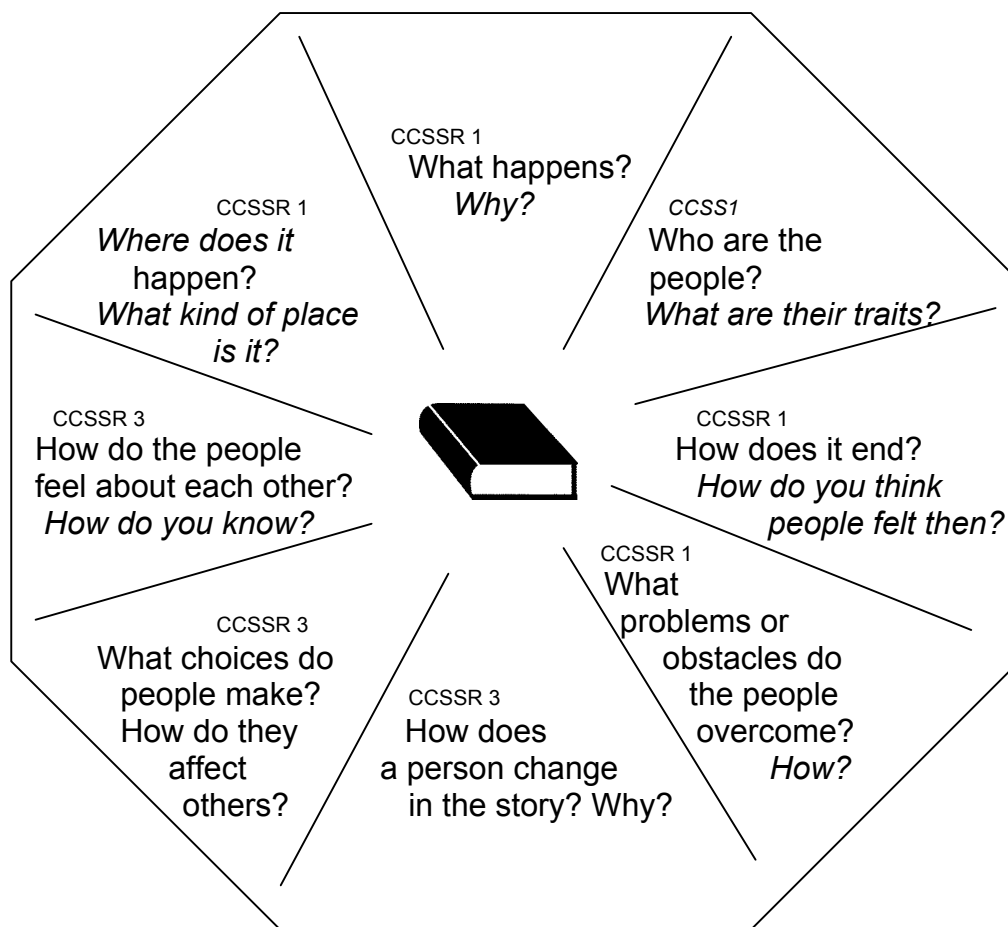
Common Questions for Thoughtful Fiction Readers
