

READING Constructed Response Organizer

A constructed response question is a reading and thinking prompt. It asks you to find important information in the passage that you will use when you answer the question.

Take each of these steps to learn how to write a good constructed response.

1. Read the question carefully.
2. Re-read the passage. **Think about the question.**
3. What is your answer? What will you explain?

3. List important information from the passage that supports your answer.

5. Organize your answer.

Part 1 Introduction

What is my main point?

Put a 1 next to the information you will use in this part.

Part 2

What is the idea I will explain with examples?

Put 2 next to the information you will use in this part.

Part 3

What will I explain to make my answer clear?

Put 3 next to information you will use in this part.

6. Write your answer.

7. Read your answer.

Ask yourself:

- What information would make it stronger?
- How can I make it clearer?
