



## Calendar of Hope

Directions: Make a grid that includes the days of the week. For each day, choose a different proverb or saying. Put that on the calendar. Then have students illustrate it. We started this one as an example. Students can do this individually and as a class. You can post the picture below the saying on the calendar and at the end of each week post it as an exhibit about hope.
