

Strengthen Inference with Challenging Questions

KIND OF INFERENCE	TRANSFERABLE QUESTION	Support your answer—cite evidence from the text.
Infer from context	• What does mean?	
Infer motive	• Why does do?	
Infer cause- effect relations	What happens because? What caused? What resulted because?	
Infer prior actions	What might have happened before?	
Infer predictions	What do you think will do next? How would the story change if?	
Infer feelings	What do you think said about this? How do you think felt?	
Infer traits	What is a trait of? What might have said? Which person might have said this?	
Infer the main idea	What is the main idea of the passage?What is the best title for this passage?	List or underline the parts of the text that support it.
Infer the author's purpose	Why did the writer write this? What did the writer want you to feel or understand?	

Make sure students can draw LOGICAL conclusions: Ask students to take the second step: support your answer.
