Ways to assess student learning—to identify students' progress and needs—that informs teachers that there is a problem and what kind of problem it is.		Response to Learning NeedsWays to help students who need support.
1.	Students respond to open-ended questions.	peer coach     teacher models     students model
2.	Students answer multiple-choice questions and explain the reason for the choice.	<ol> <li>help them write notes that explain it</li> <li>give clear written steps to follow</li> <li>give example</li> <li>students work in pairs</li> <li>"chunk" the content or skill—break it into smaller parts</li> <li>complete a graphic organizer</li> </ol>
3.	Students complete a graphic organizer.	
4.	Students write explanations of how to use a skill.	
5.	Students write daily response about what they learn.	10
