

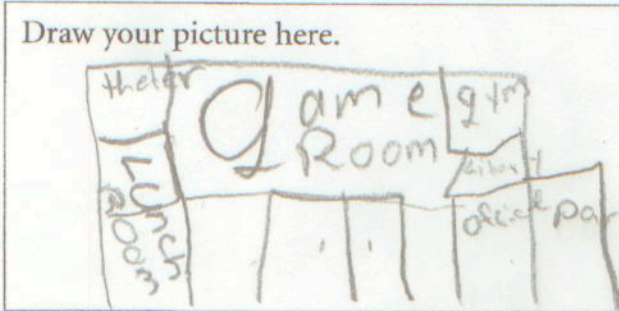

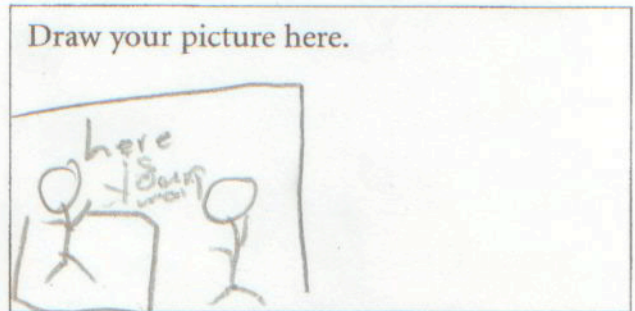

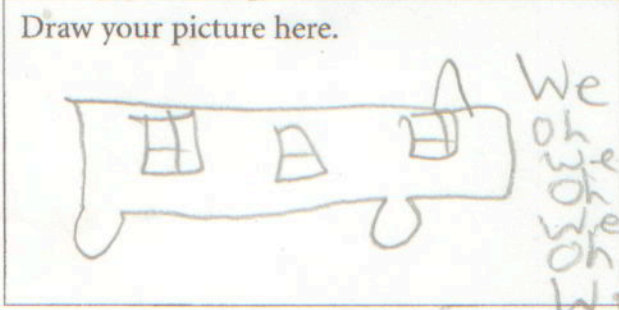
From the class list, choose words that you think are important about your community. Draw a picture, write the word, then tell what it means.



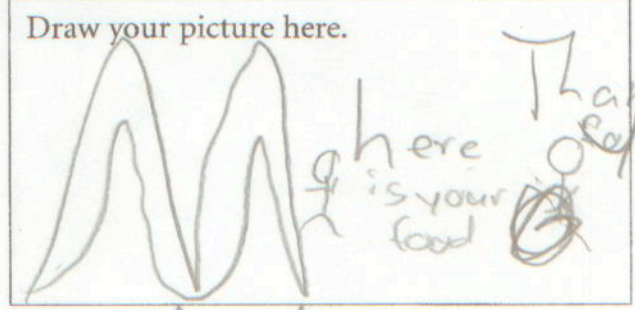
Word: community center
