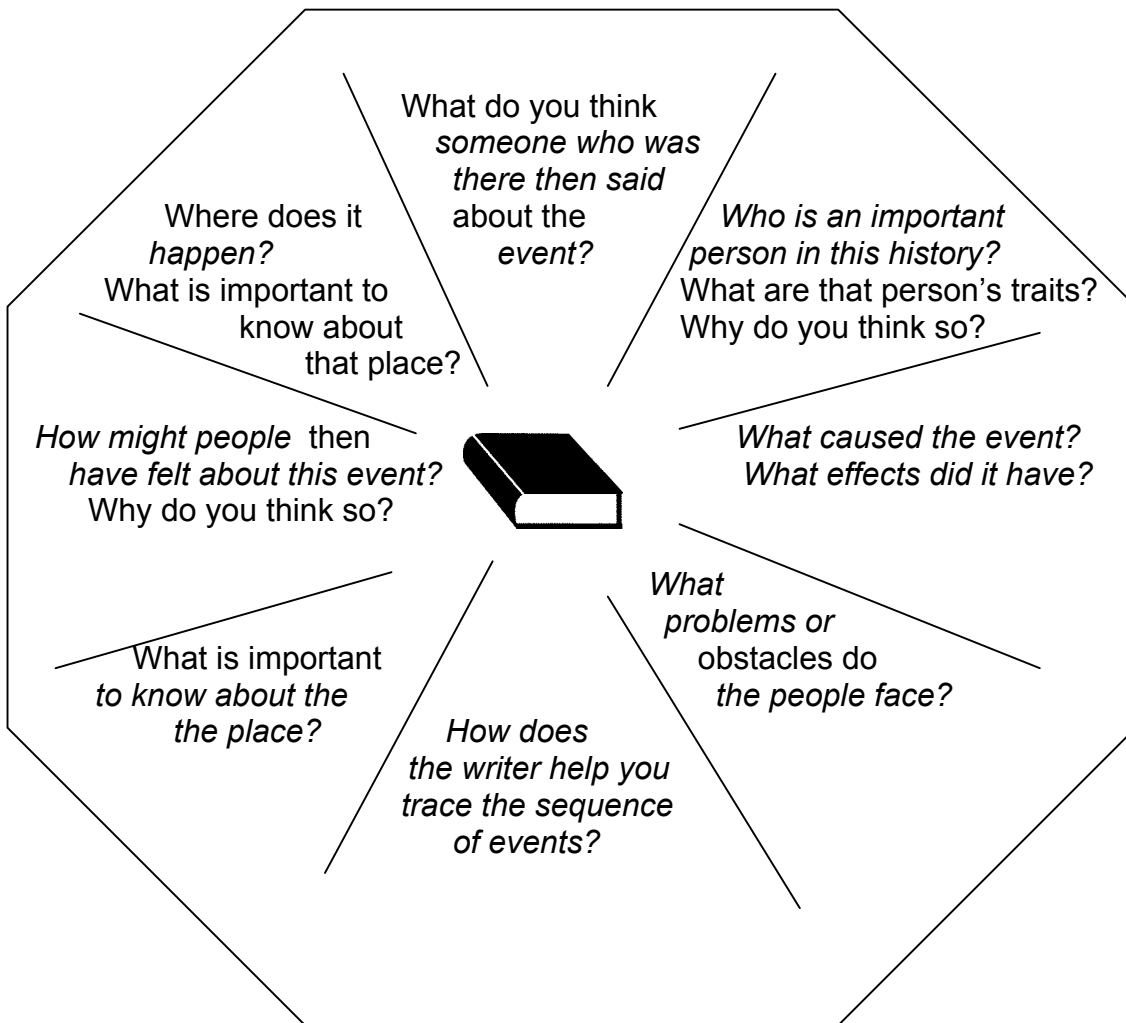


Analyze History
