## PQROST is a clear path to nonfiction reading and learning in science or social studies.

PQROST to make sure students learn more.

- Ρ Teacher **previews** the learning—sets a **purpose** for reading/listening doing.
- Q Teacher asks a **big question** that the students will answer by reading, researching, thinking.
- R and O Students read/research to find information relating to the BIG question, locating and collecting information,

information that they **organize** using a graphic organizer.

S Students **summarize** and **synthesize** their learning. Recommended for K-2: Teacher guides summary

Recommended for 3-4: Students summarize, teacher guides synthesis.

Recommended for 5-8: Students summarize then the synthesize with teacher support.

Т Students **tell/teach** what they have learned.

They may pair and share.

They may make a booklet or exhibit to "show and tell" what they learned.
