An idea is a way of thinking about something. For example, Chicago is the name of a city.

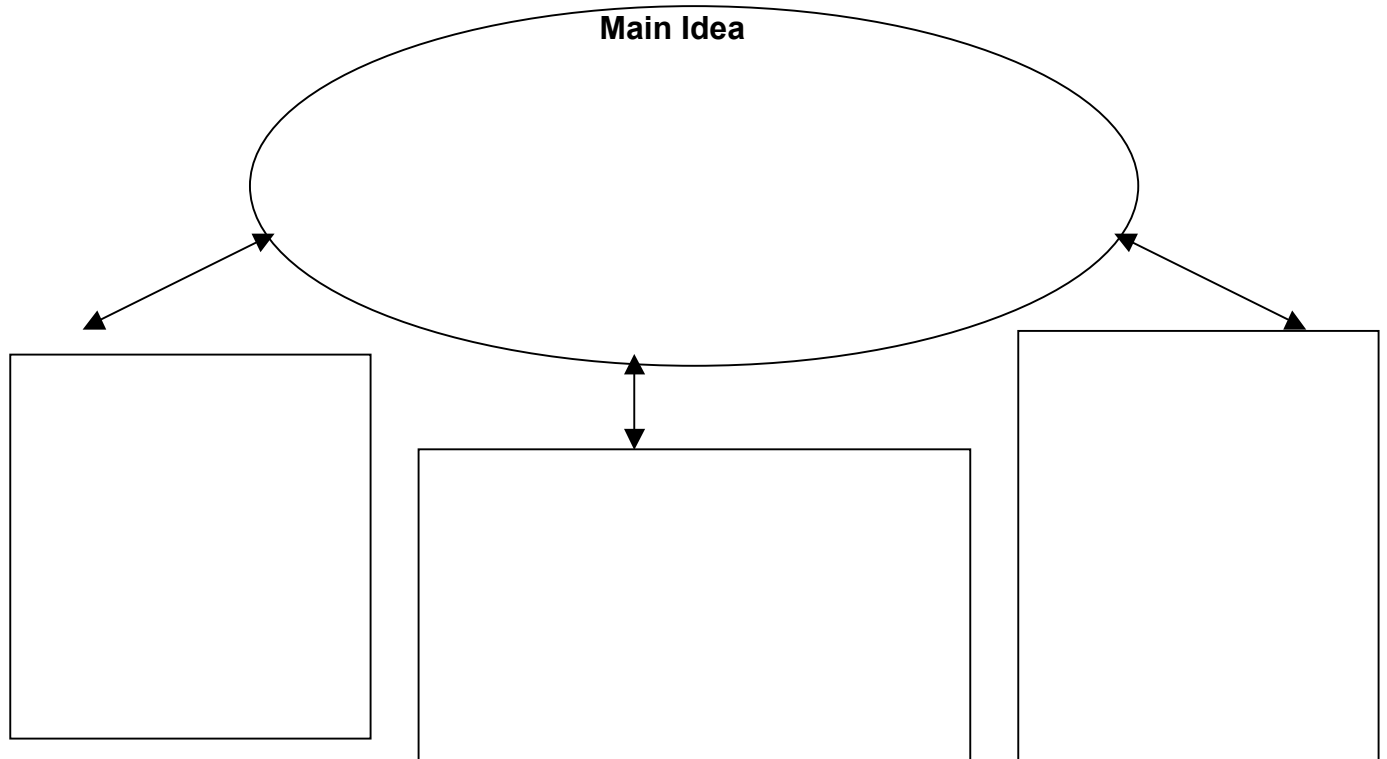
Chicago is a big busy city is an idea, a way of thinking about the city.
